The instructions shall include the markings, or equivalent as specified in "Marking Requirements" .

Where applicable:

When using an electrical furnishing, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- 1. Never operate this furnishing if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water. Return the furnishing to a service center for examination and repair.
- 2. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- 3. Do not use outdoors.

Utility Table Parts List:

- 1. Upright 'H' Legs x2, Includes levelers
- 2. Apron Frame (drawer optional)
- 3. Bolts x8 and Washers x8

Table assembly instructions:

Figure "1"

A. With Apron Frame upside-down - align the captive nuts in 'H' Legs with the bolt-holes in the apron. Repeat for the opposite side.

B. Insert 1 bolt with 1 washer and thread into the openings x4 per 'H" Leg. Tighten the each bolt using 7/16" socket to 15-20 ft-lbs of torque.

Figure "2":

Double-check that the legs are properly tightened and square to the apron.

Return the table to upright position and adjust the levelers as required. Add the optional lower leg boots when required.
